Tournament Eligibility

All sanctioned players must have played in a minimum of 8 full calendar weeks of scheduled league matches by December 22 and be deemed an active player by his/her charter holder to participate in this event.

Tournament Format

This tournament is governed by VNEA rules. All team and singles entries are prepaid. Scotch Doubles, Hard Luck and Mini-Tournament entries will be accepted on site.

- All Women's and Novice 16 game format
- Intermediate 20 game format
- Advanced and Masters 25 game format
- (maximum 7 players per roster)

Each team must be comprised of 2 original members (Exception: Masters). Additional members must be from within their own charter. **The 2 original members must play in every round.** Team captains will be required to register at specified times prior to the start of matches. Any changes to rosters must be done at this time and stats for substitutes must be provided. Players may be listed on more than one roster, but may play on only one team, even if that team is eliminated.

Team Format

All team events are Double Elimination

Men's/Mixed Teams - 4 levels of play

Novice: Designed with the Fun or Rec level player in mind. No Vegas trip winners or Masters players are allowed in this division. 4 player team. **All Fun and Regular Vegas teams are eligible. NO team with more than 8 total feats (Ero's, 1st Attempts) on their team should enter this division.**

Intermediate: For the average player. All **Super Vegas** teams will be allowed to compete in this division. No Intermediate Vegas trip winners or Masters players are allowed in this division. 5 player team.

Advanced: For the above average players. Any **Premier Super Premier or Open** players must compete in this division. No Masters players are allowed in this division. 5 player team.

Masters: 5 player team. An Open Masters Team may be comprised of any 5 players from within the Charter Holders League system so long as they meet the 8 league night requirement.

Ladies Teams - 3 levels of play

Intermediate: For the average female player. **ALL Women's Regular Teams are allowed to play in this division.** No previous Vegas trip winners from a Fun, Rec or Open level or Masters players will be allowed in this division. 4 player team.

Advanced: For the above average female player. Any previous Vegas trip winners must compete in this division. No Masters players are allowed in this division. 4 player team.

Masters: 4 player team. A Ladies Masters Team may be comprised of any 4 female players from within the Charter Holders League system so long as they meet the 8 league night requirement.

Sportsman Division

This division is available for teams who are eliminated early from the Main Event! *Check draw sheets for eligibility.* There are 2 tournament brackets:

- Sportsman 'A' Division - 4 person teams
- Sportsman 'B' Division - 5 person teams

Teams who are eligible, if interested, **PAY NO ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE** and share in the overall prize purse.

Singles Format

All singles events are **DOUBLE**

Elimination

- Men's Novice: Race to 3 games A&B
- Men's Intermediate: Race to 4 A, 3 on B
- Men's Advanced: Race to 5 on A, 4 on B
- Men's Masters: Race to 6 on A, 5 on B
- Ladies Novice: Race to 3 games A&B
- Ladies Advanced: Race to 4 on A, 3 on B
- Ladies Masters: Race to 5 on A 4 on B

Scotch Doubles - Single Elimination

Teams will consist of one male and one female player from within any qualified WCVNEA charter members league and have the 8 week minimum league night requirement. Two divisions of play: Novice/Intermediate or Advanced/Masters. **Entry Fee \$50 Per Team, Green Fee included**

Team Matches

All matches will be played on two tables with times and table assignments posted. The match must begin on time and absent players will have until the end of that round to show up. At the end of the round, the no-show player will lose the game 10-0. This rule applies for all rounds. If no team members are available after 15 minutes, the team will be forfeited by the tournament committee.

Dress Code

No suggestive attire. Players may not compete while wearing ripped, torn or stained clothing. Players will present themselves in a neat and clean appearance. The dress code will be in affect and enforced while any competition is ongoing, including mini-tournaments. Players will be given 15 minutes to change into appropriate attire.
